CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Allan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source

through a well, pipeline and trough for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Sec. 30, T. 36N., R. 50E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 30 bears N. 41° 40' E., a distance of 3,725 feet

situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Battle Mountain, Nevada

Amount of appropriation .0094 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation November 25, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed by a well, delivered by a 1 1/2" pipeline 350 feet to a stockwatering pond located within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 30, T. 36N., R. 50E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used for watering 300 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
