CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J.R. Caldwell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and pipeline system for milling and environmental purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 33, T.28N., R.32E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S 1/2 corner of said Sec. 33 bears S. 1° 05' 14" W., a distance of 2093.93 feet. situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.7 c.f.s, but not to exceed 165.1 m.g.a.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 28, 1975

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 50 hp motor, then conveyed 500' by a 4" pipeline to the milling plant area located in portions of NW 1/4 SE 1/4 and NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 33, T.28N., R.32E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used for milling and environmental purposes.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
