CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source

through drilled well, pipeline and trough for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 23, T.23N., R.40E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 35, T.23N., R.40E., M.D.B. & M., bears S. 25° 51' 24" W., a distance of 11,907.60 feet.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Austin, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.016 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1000 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

Date of priority of appropriation March 15, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is conveyed through a 2" pipe 18 1/2" to a water trough which is located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
