CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Eugene B. Longfield, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pressure tank and distribution system for commercial and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 23, T.20N., R.19E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 23 bears N. 76° 47' 35" W., a distance of 842.82 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Mar-Don Mobile Lodge
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: .026 c.f.s., not to exceed 1.34 million gallons annually
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 11, 1976

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is conveyed through a pressure tank and distribution system to service 20 single family mobile homes within the W 1/4 of Section 23, T.20N., R.19E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used for commercial and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total combined duty under this Certificate and any Certificate issued under Permit 29988 shall not exceed 1.34 million gallons annually.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
