CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Walter G. Reid, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Pine Grove Canyon through an excavation, pipeline, reservoir and pump for mining and milling

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 32, T.10N., R.26E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 32 bears N 66 degrees 16' E. a distance of 2813.0 feet.

situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator W. J. Cavanaugh
Post-office address Los Angeles, California
Amount of appropriation 0.125 c.f.s., not to exceed 15.0 million gallons per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 3, 1968

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is developed by means of an excavation to bedrock in the old channel of Pine Grove Canyon, thence piped through a 3" line to a 100,000 gallon plastic lined reservoir, thence pumped by means of centrifugal pump to a mill site located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 32, T.10N., R.26E., M.D.B.& M. where it is used in the milling operation.

The total combined duty of water under this certificate and any certificate issued under Permit 24812 shall not exceed 15 million gallons per annum.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
