CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan Means, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Eagle Gulch Creek and Tributaries through the natural drainage channel for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, T.42N., R.18E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 12 bears S 16° 18' 17" E. a distance of 4,667.47 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.298 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1250 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 14, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water from the spring flows in its natural channel where it is used for stockwatering 1250 head of cattle located within the SW 1/4, SE 1/4, NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, N 1/2 NE 1/4 all in Section 12; SE 1/4 SE 1/4, N 1/2 SE 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4 and Lots 2 and 3 all in Section 1, T.42N., R.18E. and within T.43N., R.18E. as follows SE 1/4 SE 1/4, N 1/2 SE 1/4, N 1/2 SW 1/4, all in Section 35, and the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 34.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permits.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
