CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Eugene B. Longfield, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source

through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial and domestic

purposes The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 31, T.24S., R.57E. MDB&M or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 31 bears S76°43'57"W a distance of 2599.67 feet

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533 425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows

Name of appropriator Bell Telephone Company of Nevada

Post-office address Reno, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.01 cfs but not to exceed 0.02 mga

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation November 21, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is conveyed to a pressure tank thence to a community dial office all located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein
