CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. R. Caldwell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 3, T. 39N., R. 39E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 3 bears N 89°13'W, a distance of 4756 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533 425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows

Amount of appropriation 6.0 c.f.s., not to exceed 2659.68 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from March 15th to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 6, 1972

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 3.6 acre-feet per acre per season from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein
