CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan F. Walter, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for municipal and domestic purposes The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 23, T.20S., R.60E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the SW Corner of said Section 23 bears S.64° 48'01"W., a distance of 662.29 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533 425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows

Name of appropriator Las Vegas Valley Water District
Post-office address Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 1.00 cfs but not to exceed 723.0 acre-feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation July 30, 1941

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, thence pumped through a pipeline to a 30,000 gallon pressurized retention tank and then into the distribution system of the Las Vegas Valley Water District. The place of use is within the Las Vegas Valley Water District where it is used for municipal and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of permit 10706 certificate 3009, hence the date of priority of appropriation remains the same as permit 10706.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein
