CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harold Chisholm, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, pressure tanks and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 8, T.19N., R.29E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the SE Corner of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Section 8 bears S.82° 22'26"E., a distance of 98.26 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533 425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lahontan Valley Water Company, Inc.
Post-office address: Fallon, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.04 cfs, not to exceed 3.285 mga
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 18, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, pressure tanks and distribution system to supply water to nine (9) homes located in portions of the S 1/2 NW 1/4 and NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 8, T.19N, R.29E., MDB&M where it is used for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein
