CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jack Healy has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from J. S. Bar Springs through a collection box, pipe, storage tank and distribution system for Quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows. SE 1/4, NE 1/4 Section 9, T.16N., R.19E., MDB&M or at a point from which E 1/4 Corner of said Section 9 bears S87° 49'00"E, a distance of 1168.26 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.011 cfs not to exceed 1.643 mga
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 16, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by a two foot high, two foot wide, six foot long spring box, then the water is piped 1700 feet to a 1650 gallon storage tank and then distributed to service three homes located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 10, T.16N., R.19E., MDB&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein
