CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bruce R. Scott, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 31, T.14N., R.20E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the SE Corner of said Section 31 bears S34° 16'E., a distance of 2396 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533 425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows

Amount of appropriation 0.25 cfs, not to exceed 36.0 ac.-ft. per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 23, 1973

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:
9.0 acres in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 31, T.14N., R.20E., MDB&M

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein
