CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jack N. Tedford has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for industrial (air quality control) purposes The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 13, T.19N., R.27E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 13 bears S. 11° 48' 20" W., a distance of 644.75 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533 425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows.

Amount of appropriation 0.01 c.f.s. not to exceed 2.36 mga - 0.01 c.f.s. = 2.359 mga, therefore permitted amount (37.44 mga) cannot be achieved
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 30, 1971

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, pump and distribution pipelines in industrial water service for air quality control and "scrubber" in an asphalt plant located within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 13, T.19N., R.27E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein
