CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles C. Armuth, Jr., Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, T.35N., R.55E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 35 bears S. 21° 06' E., a distance of 914.62 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533 425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.011 c.f.s., not to exceed 0.657 mga
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 20, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and conveyed through a pressure system, a 50 gallon storage tank and pipelines to one single family dwelling and appurtenances located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion where water is used for domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein
