CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Eugene B. Longfield, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground source through a drilled well, pump, pressure tank and distribution system for commercial and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 (Lot 11) Section 19, T.21N., R.18E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 19 bears N. 44° 26' 54" E., a distance of 1,039.12 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Joe E. and Natalie Gardner
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.03 c.f.s., not to exceed 1.51 m.g.a.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 15, 1976

Description of work of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is conveyed by a pressure tank and distribution system to a bar, restaurant, service station, single family residence and park, all located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where water is used for commercial and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
