CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, David F. Causey, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring (Lee Canyon) through demand collection basin, pipe line, storage tank and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 11, T.19S., R.56E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 11 bears S. 85° 25' W., a distance of 2,410 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Las Vegas, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.09 c.f.s., not to exceed 4.4 million gal. per season  
Period of use, from June 1st to September 30th of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation November 16, 1970

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed by means of a dam and collection basin, thence conveyed by means of a 3/4" water line, to a 7,000 gallon holding tank and distribution system for service to 20 cabins located within the S 1/2 SW 1/4 Section 2, T.19S., R.56E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
