CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Marie C. Beers has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe through pump and distribution system domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 34, T.14N., R.18E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 34 bears N. 31° 45' E., a distance of 2758 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.02 c.f.s. but not to exceed 0.022 mga.  
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation January 26, 1971

Description of works of diversion, place of use, and manner of use:  
Water is pumped from Lake Tahoe by a submersible pump, through 100' of 1 1/2" pipe, 20' of 1 1/2" pipe, 50' of 1" pipe and 140' of 3/4" pipe to a single residence located within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 34, T.14N., R.18E., M.D.B. & M., and is used there for domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
