CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Katherine J. Peek has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 9, T.22S., R.61E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of said Section 9 bears N. 15° 17' 04" W., a distance of 524.75 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows: Name of appropriator: Floyd J. Peek or Katherine J. Peek; Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada; Amount of appropriation: 0.015 c.f.s., not to exceed 4.2 acre feet per year; Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year; * Date of priority of appropriation: May 20, 1948

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant: 0.7 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 9, T.22S., R.61E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.2 acre-feet per annum from any and/or all sources.

* This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 12457, Certificate 3866; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 12457, Certificate 3866.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
