CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Walter G. Reid has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4, SE 1/4, NW 1/4, Section 33, T. 17N., R. 22E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N 1/2 corner of said Section 33 bears N. 22° 00' 48" E., a distance of 2187.70 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Nellie Morrison
Post-office address: Carson City, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.2125 c.f.s., but not to exceed 39.2 ac-ft per annum
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation: July 14, 1972

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant: 9.8 acres in the SW 1/4, SE 1/4, NW 1/4, Section 33, T. 17N., R. 22E., M.D.B. & M.

* Permit 29011 changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 26833; therefore, the date of priority of appropriation remains the same as Permit 26833.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre annually from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
