CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John R. Sterling has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 28, T. 17N. R. 22E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 28 bears S. 50° 45' E., a distance of 1925.61 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.06 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.35 m.g.a.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 24, 1976

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed in a well, thence conveyed to a storage tank and distributed by pipe line to the garden areas and two mobile homes located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
