CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Calvin F. Gunn, President has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Un-named Spring No. 3 through concrete diversion box, storage tank and distribution system for commercial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 29, T.17N., R.19E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N 1/2 corner of said Section 29 bears N. 17 degrees E., a distance of 1670 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.05 c.f.s., not to exceed 11.794 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 21, 1970

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a concrete block spring box and is transported to storage tanks and a distribution system located within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 29, SW 1/4 SE 1/4, S 1/2 NW 1/4 SE 1/4, S 1/2 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 20, all within T.17N., R.19E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used for commercial purposes at the ski resort for the lodge, housing, landscaping and snowmaking.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
