CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jack Rose has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, T.35N., R.55E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 35 bears S. 30° 07' 15" E., 1704.5 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.079 c.f.s., but not to exceed 10.0 ac-ft annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 5, 1974

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:
2.5 acres in Lot 6, Section 35, T.35N., R.55E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
