CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

Witness, Roger Roussille has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 27, T.18N. R.20E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Section 27 bears S. 13° 01' 26" W., 1205.48 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Trans-Sierra Water Service, Inc.
Post-office address Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 1.00 c.f.s., but not to exceed 157.68 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 15, 1970

Description of works of diversion and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, pump and distribution system and commingled with water from other sources where it is used to supply 700 single family residences within the S 1/2 NW 1/4, SW 1/4, E 1/2 Sec. 27 and all of Sec. 34, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
