CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Edward L. Pine has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for Fish and Wildlife Research and domestic purposes purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 16, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of Section 21, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., bears S 70 31' 59" W., a distance of 5802.29 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Board of Regents, University of Nevada
Post-office address University of Nevada, Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.045 c.f.s., but not to exceed 6.308 million gallons annually.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 9, 1974

Description of works of diversion and manner of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well, pump and distribution system. Water is distributed through a pressure and temperature regulated system into twenty rectangular fish rearing tanks all within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 16, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for Fish and Wildlife Research.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
