CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John R. Weber has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and stock tank for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 2, T.19N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 2 bears S. 37° 28' 57" W., a distance of 2780.0 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Pioneer Citizens Bank of Nevada Trust Dept.
Post-office address: P.O. Box 2351, Reno, Nevada 89505
Amount of appropriation: 0.0062 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 20, 1975

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well and pump where it is pumped to stockwatering tanks within the same subdivision as the point of diversion and is used to water 200 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
