CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. V. Gaselli has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Sheep Mountain Spring through diversion works, pipeline and troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 9, T.1N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 6, T.1N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 61° 51' W., a distance of 16,674.25 feet, situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.00446 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 20, 1975

Description of diversion works, manner and place of use: Water is developed from Sheep Mountain Spring and then piped to stockwatering troughs located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 9, T.1N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used to water 500 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
