CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bruce R. Scott has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from King's Canyon Creek through diversion dam, pumps, meter and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 23, T.15N., R.19E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 23 bears N. 63° 40' 55" E., 2421.5 feet situated in Carson City County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Richard D. and Nancy B. Grundy
Post-office address: Carson City, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per annum
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year

\* Date of priority of appropriation: As decreed

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant: 1.97 acres in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 23, T.15N., R.19E., M.D.B. & M.

\* This permit is to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of King's Canyon Creek as heretofore appropriated under the Civil Decree of November 14, 1885, thus this permit 28351 retains that date of priority.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and conditions of the State Engineer's ruling dated January 10, 1975.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
