CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard W. Forman, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground source (Artesian Well No. 3) through artesian well, pipe and trough for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2, T.14N., R.43E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the southwest corner of said Section 2 bears S. 26° 43' 36" W., a distance of 5,483.16 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: John E. S. and Barbara J. Buchanan
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.00446 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle and 10 horses
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation: September 11, 1964

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from an artesian well, thence conveyed through a 2" pipe-line into a 100-gallon drum located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion, where it is used to water 300 head of cattle and 10 horses.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

* Permit 30666 changes the point of diversion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 22239, Certificate 6950; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as under Permit 22239.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
