CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank Souza, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 10, T.7N., R.29E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 10, T.7N., R.29E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 86° 01' W., a distance of 5,278.2 feet situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 13, 1975

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed in the well, pumped, thence conveyed by a pipeline to storage tanks, thence via a distribution system where it is used for municipal purposes within the service area of Hawthorne Town, which is Section 27, T.8N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
