CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Roger Hope, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring (#2) through small dam, pipeline, distribution system for domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 33, T.32N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 33 bears N. 16° 53' E., a distance of 3,404.35 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Roger Hope and Rolling Mountain Thunder
Post-office address Imlay, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.1 c.f.s., but not to exceed 657,000 gallons per year
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 3, 1973

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a cement dam from the developed spring and then piped 350 feet to place of use within the same subdivision where it is used for domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
