CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Joe B. Fallini, Jr., Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, windmill and trough for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 32, T.4N., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 32, bears S. 26° 0' E., a distance of 4,492.07 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.025 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 600 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 14, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is diverted by means of a drilled well, windmill and trough which waters 600 head of cattle all within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 32, T.4N., R.53E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
