CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles C. Armuth, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Buffalo Spring #1 through a developed spring, ditch and pond for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 6, T.29N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 6, T.29N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 20° 52' W., a distance of 1755 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0011 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 250 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 5, 1976

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from the spring area by a small ditch and conveyed to a pond which is 3 feet deep and square shape, 50 feet on each side, whence it is used to water 250 head of cattle, which is located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 6, T.29N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
