CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 20, T.36N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 22, T.36N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 72° 45' 02" E., a distance of 10,461.00 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.006 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.657 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 10, 1976

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a 75 foot deep 6 inch casing well, equipped with 1/2 H.P. submersible pump and used for domestic use within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 20, T.36N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
