CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, B. J. Vasey, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source

through a drilled well, pump and troughs stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 11, T.13N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 11, bears N. 54° 27' W., a distance of 2,260 feet

situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Frank Settelmeyer & Sons, Inc.

Post-office address Minden, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0156 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

\* Date of priority of appropriation January 9, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is produced from an 8 inch drilled well 100 feet deep, pumped with a 1 H.P. submersible pump into two (2) 4 foot x 12 foot x 18 foot troughs within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 11, T.13N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used to water 500 head of cattle.

\* This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 19434, Certificate 5419, hence the date of priority remains the same as that of Permit 19434, Certificate 5419.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
