CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank W. Gentry, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from a Spring (West Sutro Spring) through a diversion box and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 8, T.17N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 8 bears S. 39° 36' W., a distance of 1441.0 feet situated in Storey County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation .020 c.f.s., but not to exceed 12.28 acre-feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 12, 1972

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
3.07 acres in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 8, T.17N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
