CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well and distribution system for mining and milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 Sec. 32, T. 28N., R. 46E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 32 bears S. 30° 15' 49" W., a distance of 1856.15 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Imco Services, a Division of Halliburton Company
Post-office address: Houston, Texas
Amount of appropriation: 0.152 c.f.s., not to exceed 15 million gallons annually
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 19, 1976

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped from the well and conveyed via 1592 feet of 4" pipeline to a storage pond to be used in a jig mill, conveyed via 758 feet of an 8" pipeline. After use the water is conveyed to talings pond #1 and #2 by 862' of open ditch and returned to the storage pond for re-use. All located within Sec. 32, T. 28N., R. 46E., M.D.B.&M.

This permit is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
