CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John F. Smales, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and municipal water system for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 3, T.34N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 3 bears S. 21° 41' W., a distance of 835.00 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: City of Elko
Post-office address: Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 1,827 c.f.s., not to exceed 431.0 million gallons per annum
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 13, 1967

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is developed from the well and pumped into the municipal distribution system where it is used for municipal and domestic purposes within the city limits of the City of Elko in Sections 2, 3, 9, 10, 11, 14, 15, 16, 21 and 22, T.34N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
