CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mary Lou Hale, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Deep or Big Spring through diversion works and distribution system for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 19, T.18S., R.51E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the Center 1/4 corner of said Section 19 bears S. 11° 10' 56" W., a distance of 910 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Mary Lou Hale and I. K. Deeds
Post-office address: Death Valley Junction, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.953 c.f.s., not to exceed 104.40 acre-feet per annum
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
*Date of priority of appropriation: October 11, 1945

Description of the land to which the water is appurtenant:
20.88 Acres in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 24, T.18S., R.50E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

*This certificate changes the place of use of Permit 11384, Certificate 4484. Therefore the date of priority remains the same as Permit 11384, Certificate 4484.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
