CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for milling and mining purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 8, T.28N., R.44E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 5, T.28N., R.44E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 10° 19' 02" E., a distance of 5907.29 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.145 c.f.s., not to exceed 1.825 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 17, 1976

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted through a drilled well, pump and distributed to various parts of an open pit mining and milling operation via water truck for use in areas within the SE 1/4 of Section 5; SW 1/4 of Section 4; NE 1/4 of Section 8; and the NW 1/4 of Section 9, all within T.28N., R.44E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
