CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James P. Haddan, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from sewage effluent (Carson City Sewage Treatment Plant) through pumping station, transmission line and storage for Irrigation (golf course and softball fields) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 15, T.15N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Section 15 bears S. 34° 20' E., a distance of 690 feet. situated in Carson City County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

This certificate is issued subject to the terms and conditions under Permit 25727 and also the terms and conditions of this Permit 25727-S-1.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
