CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James Parker, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and pressure system for Commercial and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 36, T.16N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/2 corner of said Section 36 bears S. 62° 03" W., a distance of 408.7 feet situated in Carson City County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.11 c.f.s., but not to exceed 3.376 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 8, 1971

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed in the well, thence conveyed by a pressure system into the distribution system, which serves 8 warehouses, 1 laundry facility, 1 recreation center, 2 homes, 4 apartments and some 1100' of trees and shrubs; all within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 36, T.16N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
