CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bruce R. Scott, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Commercial and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 6, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 6 bears N. 27° 09' 20" W., a distance of 1387.2 feet.

situated in Carson City County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Clear Creek Enterprises, Inc.

Post-office address Carson City, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.35 c.f.s., but not to exceed 4,326 million gallons annually

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 28, 1973

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed in a 245 foot deep well, thence conveyed to a storage tank via a distribution system to the place of use within a portion of the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, and also a portion of the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 6, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used within a Drive-In Theater, Racquetball Club, construction yard and office, a warehouse storage and a publishing company.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
