WHEREAS, Susan Lindsey, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄ Section 28, T.15N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N¹/₄ corner of said Section 28 bears N. 08°33' E., a distance of 503 feet situated in Carson City, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 242 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 1.5 H.P. pump, thence through a distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic water service to one single family dwelling with landscaping located within the SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄ Section 28, T.15N., R.20E., M.D.B. &M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

This corrected certificate is issued to correct the location of the place of use.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
