CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, B. J. Vasey, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Spring #2

through developed spring, pipe and tank for stockwater and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 22, T.13N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 22 bears S 16° 32' W., a distance of 1632 feet

situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator R. D. Alexander

Post-office address Gardnerville, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0005 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle and 25 head of horses

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 7, 1976

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is produced from the spring and Spring #1, combined in a central collection system, thence conveyed to a 1000 gallon storage tank and 2 foot x 2 foot x 4 foot trough and used to water cattle and horses within portions of the NW 1/4 SW 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SE 1/4 SE 1/4, NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SE 1/4 NE 1/4 and SW 1/4 NE 1/4; all in Section 22, T.13N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
