CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Spring #1, diversion box and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Section 36, T.37N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S¹/₄ corner of said Section 36 bears S. 59°05' W., a distance of 978 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation:	0.02 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.68 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is diverted from Spring #1 by means of a diversion box, thence through a distribution system for irrigation of 0.17 acres of garden located within a portion of the SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Section 36, T.37N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
