CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, B. J. Vasey, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Unnamed Spring #6 through developed spring and stock trough for stockwater and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 33, T.47N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 33 bears N. 39° 52' E., a distance of 971 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0005 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 800 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 16, 1976

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from the spring, which consists of a 24 inch diameter perforated drum with a 2 inch pipe to a 4 foot x 14 foot steel trough, located within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 33, T.47N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used to water 800 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
