CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 24, T.42N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 24 bears N. 47° 08' E., a distance of 1871 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.07 c.f.s., but not to exceed 13,033 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 22, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed in a 700 foot drilled well, 10 inch casing, equipped with a submersible pump, thence conveyed to a pressure tank thence via a pipeline 100 feet in length to a jig plant and trailer homes, all within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 24, T.42N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
