CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Stephen E. Francoeur, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Spring and drains of French Boy Canyon through developed spring and distribution system for domestic purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 Sec 11, T. 28N., R. 17E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 11 bears N. 85° 40' E., a distance of 403.0 feet

situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Glenbrook, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.00223 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.196 million gallons annually
Period of use, from March 1st to November 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 4, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed at the spring area, thence conveyed to a storage tank, 1000 gallon, thence via pipeline into a distribution system used for domestic use in a portion of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 and SW 1/4 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 11, T. 28N., R. 17E., M.D.B. & M.

This permit is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
