CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Louis A. Lani, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 29, T.19N., R.44E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 29 bears N. 80° 18' W., a distance of 1512.0 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Lander County Sewer and Water District No. 2
Post-office address Austin, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.223 c.f.s., but not to exceed 14.331 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 2, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by a 450 foot deep drilled well, 6 inch casing, equipped with a 4 inch stainless steel submersible 3 HP pump, which pumps the water into the distribution system, with storage tanks located at four different locations within the town limits which are: E 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, E 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 19, W 1/2 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 20, N 1/2 NW 1/4 of Section 29, and N 1/2 NE 1/4 of Section 30, all within T.19N., R.44E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
