CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ross E. de Lipkau, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for milling, mining and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 28, T.17S., R.49E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Section 28 bears S. 63° 45' W., a distance of 1115 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Industrial Mineral Ventures, Inc.
Post-office address: Lathrop Wells, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.089 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.629 million gallons annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 16, 1975

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed in a 151 foot deep well, 6 inch casing, equipped with a 5 HP 3-phase electric motor and is used for milling, mining and domestic use within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 28 and Section 29, T.17S., R.49E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
